### **WESTERN ANEMONE**

Uniquely shaped like mop tops, these perennial flowers can be seen in alpine meadows mid to late summer.

# **RED COLUMBINE**

Found in the mid to high elevations in mid-June to late Aug. Columbine means "dove" as it's thought the flower resembles birds sitting around a dish.

## **FIREWEED**

This beautiful purply red flower grows in abundance on the slopes of Blackcomb in July & August.

## SITKA VALERIAN

Measuring over 1 meter in height, this flower can be found on higher elevations. The root of the flower is also used as a sleeping aid.

### SKUNK CABBAGE

Common around most lakes, this Springtime plant has a distinc odor and can grow as much as 2 meters across.

### **GOAT'S BEARD**

Large patches are often found around Nita Lake and Nairn Falls. These large plants flower in mid-June.

# **TIGER LILY**

Often found in moist meadows, it is said that someone who smells a Tiger lily will develop freckles. Flowering begins mid-June.

#### SPREADING STONECROP

Common on upper Whistler Blackcomb mountains, this plump flowering succulent is a mat-forming perennial.

Similar to a Snapdragon, this beautiful perennial can be found in large patches in upper Singing Pass from July to August.
